Blessing of the Fleet Saturday May 17th

Decorate your boat and join us in a daylight parade around the lake and a party to follow with BBQ Brisket, keg beer, wine in a box, and soft drinks (or BYOB).

Bring a side dish or desert.

Registration for boat blessing and judging purposes will be done 9-11 am
at John Miller's slip M1330 BayView marina,
John Lambert's slip J4 at Captain's Cove,
or at the Chandler's Landing office.
Get a number to post on your boat.

Bass Pro pass and Blessing **12 noon**
Chandler's Landing pass about **12:30**
Harbor Project pass about **1:00**
BayView pass about **1:30**
BBQ Party on BayView K-dock 2-6pm

Detail parade instructions will be emailed to all known boaters. You may request these instructions by email to john@megaeasy.com.

General instructions are to assemble west of Robertson park about **11:30** behind the lead boat which will be facing north toward I30. Sequence will be random, just form a single line. The parade will begin at **12 noon sharp**. Boat to boat communication can be done by cell phone. VHF chan 69 will be used by the Chaplain when blessing each boat. Leave that channel free while boats are passing Bass Pro.

Fill out a registration and release form and pay \$75 annual dues to join the BayView Boat Club. A one event membership is available for \$10 by filling out a release form.
